June 2010 Status Report

Surveillance & Weather:

The rainfall total for the month of June (6.17 inches at ORD) is 2.54 inches above the average for June (3.63in.). Temperature predictions for the beginning of July are in the in the upper 80s with a chance of rain. With the expected increase in temperatures, we may see an increase in nuisance mosquito activity early and *Culex* populations as the month progresses.

To date in 2010, there have been 3 human West Nile virus cases reported to the CDC in Mississippi, Georgia, and Texas. The state of Illinois has reported 10 dead birds and 6 mosquito batches positive for West Nile virus

Brood Prediction

The floodwater mosquito (*Aedes vexans*) is the key nuisance species in the Chicagoland area. Distinct hatches of floodwater mosquito populations, or broods, are triggered by significant rainfall events. The Clarke Brood Prediction Model calculates peak annoyance periods based on rainfall and temperature data collected from weather stations in your area.

Conduct entomological survey (inspections) and surveillance to monitor larval and adult mosquito density; Maintain vector and virus surveillance; Expand community outreach and public education programs focused on risk potential and personal protection emphasizing residential source reduction.
