Many business efficiency projects include process improvements or involve multiple technologies. <p>Existing Home Retrofit Program</p>	<p>The program provides customers with personalized energy information unique to their home and energy use. For a non-refundable contribution of \$50, customers will receive a whole-house energy audit to identify cost-effective energy-saving opportunities specific to their home, as well as \$40 worth of instant upgrades for FREE, which includes installation of a water-saving massage showerhead, high-efficiency faucet aerators for kitchen and bathroom sinks, and up to ten (10) compact fluorescent light (CFL) bulbs.</p> <p>After the audit, the customer will be provided with a proposal for no-hassle, turnkey installation services for implementing the energy-efficient measures identified in the audit. Funding will be provided through the Nicor Gas Energy Efficiency Program for up to \$1,250 of the total cost for labor and materials. [Note: Partial funding provided by ComEd's <i>Smart Ideas for Your Home</i>SM program.]</p> <p><i>Note: Customers will be required to implement the entire package of recommended measures to receive the incentive; they may not choose to implement only specific items within the package.</i></p>	<p>This program is <u>NOT</u> open for customer enrollment. If you are eligible, you will be contacted directly through the mail via both a postcard and a follow-up letter two weeks later. <p>Elementary Energy Education Program</p>	<p>This program is designed to teach students and their families how to conserve energy resources by using energy more efficiently at home and at school. A maximum of 5,000 5th grade students will be provided education and a free energy-saving take-home kit to learn about and undertake simple low-cost efficiency measures in their home. They will be able to document how the changes they make result in natural gas energy savings.</p>	<p>This program is <u>NOT</u> open for public enrollment. [Note: Up to 5,000 kits will be provided to 5th grade students and teachers. Eligible schools will be contacted by the National Energy Foundation to participate. Classrooms will be accepted on a first-come strategy until the program is fully enrolled.]</p>	<p><u>Implementation Contractor:</u> National Energy Foundation (NEF) Nicor Gas' Community Relations Directors have a list of the invited schools and teachers.</p>																		
<p>Residential Multi-Family Direct Install Program</p>	<p>This program is being run in partnership with ComEd to provide a FREE, no-obligation install of the following energy-saving measures in individual living units: a water-saving massage shower-head, high-efficiency faucet aerators for kitchen and bathroom sinks, and up to six compact fluorescent light (CFL) bulbs. The implementation contractor will also look for opportunities to install energy-saving measures in building common areas and verify incentive eligibility.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Program to target property owners and managers of condominiums and apartments with eight (8) or more units. <i>(Individual customers should ask their property manager to contact the implementation contractor.)</i> Property must be served by both Nicor Gas and ComEd (to be verified by zip code). 	<p><u>Implementation Contractor:</u> Honeywell Utility Solutions 877-735-6687 [Note: All Honeywell employees carry a ComEd Identification Card for verification.]</p>																		
<p>Low-to-Moderate Income Program</p>	<p>This program will weatherize homes and repair or replace furnaces in eligible households. Participating homeowners will be asked to pay 10% of the total weatherization costs and 20% of the furnace repair/replacement costs. In addition, energy-efficient showerheads and faucet aerators will be installed in the home at no cost to the homeowner. This program is being implemented by the Illinois Association of Community Action Agencies (IACAA) and the local Community Action Agencies, but not all of the local agencies will be participating due to the limited size and scope of project (see list at right).</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The customer must be a Nicor Gas customer who owns a single-family home or duplex.
