

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION OF  
THE VILLAGE OF NORTH BARRINGTON WHICH WAS HELD MONDAY, APRIL 2, 2007 AT

1. Call to Order, Roll Call, Approve Minutes of March 5, 2007 Parks & Recreation Commission Meeting:

At 7:30 P.M Chairman Kathy Kubick called the meeting to order. The Deputy Village Clerk called the roll:

The Minutes from the March 5, 2007 Parks and Recreation Commission Meeting were made available to the Commission.

Motion: Bill Bowyer moved to approve the Minutes from the March 5, 2007 Parks and Recreation Commission Meeting; seconded by Lloyd Struttman.

Discussion: There was no discussion.

Vote on the Motion:

The voice vote was unanimous in favor.

Chairman Kathy Kubick declared the Minutes of the March 5, 2007 Parks & Recreation Meeting approved and put on file.

2. Discussion on Public Use of Eton Park Electrical Facilities

Trustee Jane Farrell explained to the Commission the recent Village resident concerns regarding the use of the electrical facilities at Eton Park. A group of residents requested the use of the electrical facilities at Eton Park for a private event. Extensive discussion previously held between President Bruce Sauer and Trustee Jane Farrell resulted in the Village decision to deny the request due to liability concerns.

3. Update on Summer Camps, Concerts and Movie Night

Chairman Kathy Kubick informed the Commission that the specifics about the July 21, 2007

Summer Concert were still in the process of being confirmed. The Summer Happenings at Eton Park Flyer will mention only the June 16, 2007 Summer Concert. The Commission also discussed the Foglia YMCA Summer Camp flyer that was recently mailed to Village residents. Commission Members decided to re-evaluate the postage costs of the flyer to the Village in January 2008. Plans are in place for the Eton Park Movie Night, scheduled for August 18, 2007. The movie ET will be featured.

4. Discussion of Concert and Movie Promotion

Chairman Kathy Kubick will order the promotional signs from Barrington Print and Copy. The Commission complimented the signage that Chairman Kubick displayed.

5. Discussion of Fall Festival

There was no new information to discuss about the Fall Festival, scheduled for October 7, 2007 at Eton Park.

6. Update on Eton Park Mulching and Tree Removal

The Commission agreed that the playground mulch that was distributed around the play set at Eton Park looked good. Village residents utilizing the facility also complimented the improvement. Chairman Kathy Kubick reported that she had contracted Top Notch to remove the dead Alder Tree at Eton Park for a charge of \$100.

7. Arbor Day

The Commission confirmed that all the plans are set for the Arbor Day celebration to be held at Eton Park April 28, 2007. Village Forester Susan Allman is coordinating the tree planting and refreshments, as well as the flyer to be sent to the residents.

8. Update on Walking Paths

Due to the recent rainy weather conditions, the Commission was unable to accurately access the work needed on the Village walking paths.

9. Trustee's Report

Trustee Jane Farrell reported to the Commission that the first of two election forums would be held April 4, 2007 at the Village Hall and urged their attendance. The second election forum is scheduled for April 11, 2007 at Biltmore Country Club.

10. Old/New Business

The Commission discussed the current drainage problem in Eton Park, along the perimeter closest to the parking lot. Trustee Jane Farrell volunteered to contact Trustee Frank Tripicchio regarding the possible installation of drain tile to alleviate the problem.

11. Adjournment

Motion: Bill Bowyer made a motion to adjourn the meeting; seconded by Jennifer Haidu.

Discussion: There was no discussion.
