

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION OF

1. Call to Order and Roll Call:

Motion: Andrew Seagren moved to approve the Minutes from the August 7, 2006 Parks and Recreation Commission Meeting; seconded by Laurie Whitmer.

Cathy Howes reviewed all the details for the upcoming Fall Festival to be held October 8, 2006 at Eton Park. The Commission extensively discussed the volunteers/responsibilities, event timeline and set up for the actual day of the Festival. It was agreed that a Damage Waiver would be purchased by the Village for the popcorn machine, the snow-cone machine and cotton candy machine, all of which will be rented for the Fall Festival.

4. Newsletter

The Village Fall Newsletter is in the process of being put together. Chairman Cassidy Towne will submit a news release from the Parks & Recreation Commission to the Village Clerk for publication.

5. Long Term Goals

The Commission will discuss its long term goals more extensively at the January 2007 Meeting.

6. Old/New Business

Chairman Cassidy Towne reported that the swing at Eton Park has been repaired. Brian Thomson will apply a fertilizer treatment at Eton Park for the fall season. New playground mulch will be distributed around the play set area in the spring of 2007. The Deputy Clerk reported that the new liner for one of the garbage cans at Eton Park was now in place.
